An amendment to House Bill One, ACT 745, requires that schools contact parents when a student has accumulated **three unexcused** tardies.

Please remember, that according to law, a child is considered habitually absent and/or tardy at the time that child accumulates **FIVE** unexcused absences/tardies. This is the time that legal action against a parent/caretaker can be pursued in the East Baton Rouge Parish Juvenile Court.

AT THE TIME A STUDENT ACCUMULATES THREE (3) UNEXCUSED TARDIES, YOUR SCHOOL Will BE COMPLYING WITH ACT 745.

In your school improvement plan (**SIP**) and your individual school handbook, you have a tardy policy response that addresses the issue as stated in the Student Rights and Responsibilities Handbook.

The TASC process will serve as the method by which ACT 745 will be addressed. By the design of the TASC program further violations will be addressed formally through the legal process.
